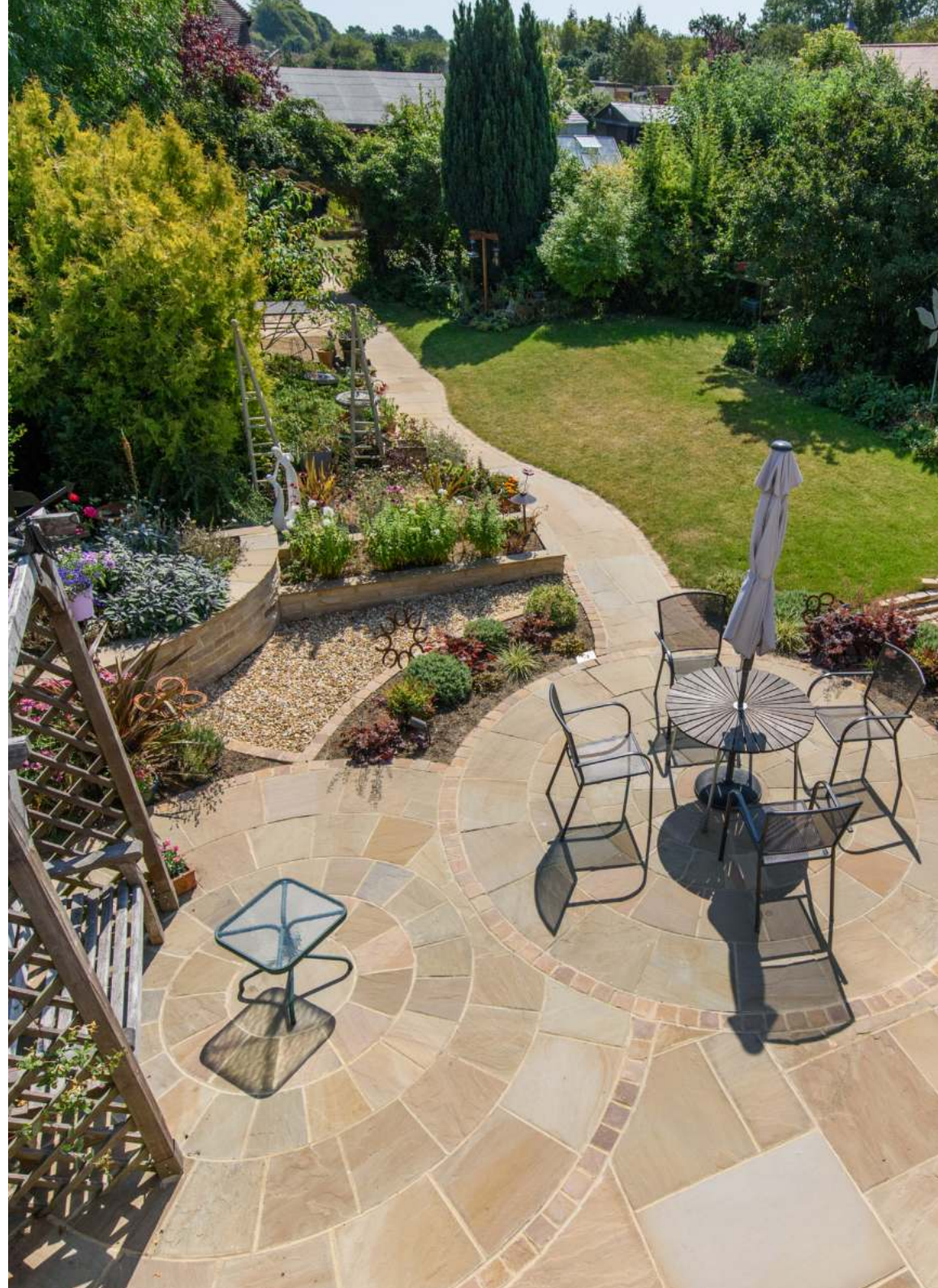



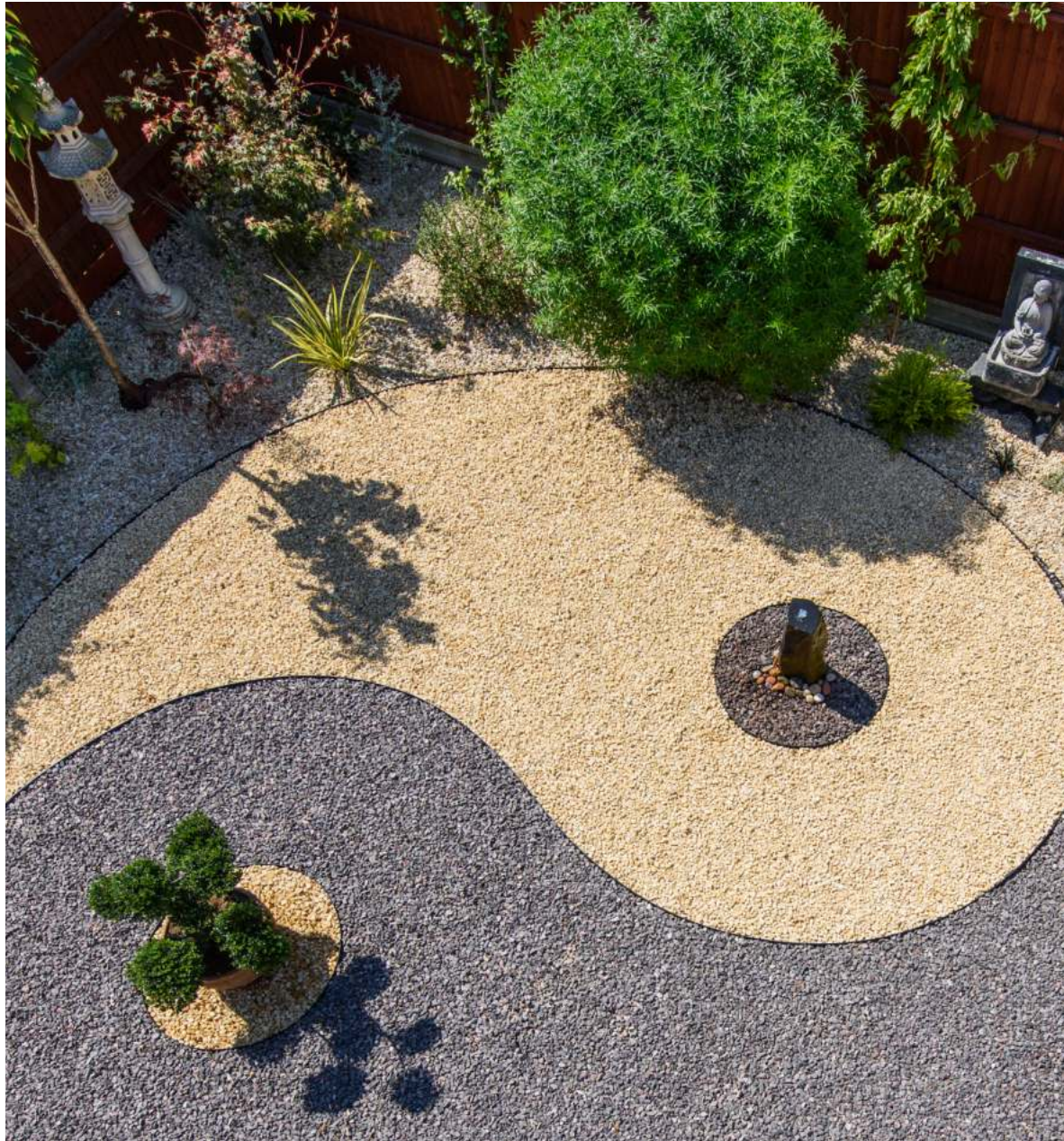

Give nature a home

Bathing blackbirds, rustling hedgehogs and buzzing bees. There's something wonderful about watching the wildlife that's chosen to visit you in your garden.

The good news is, you don't need to let your garden run wild to have a wildlife garden. You also don't need acres of space, we've created wildlife havens in the smallest of courtyards.

Introducing carefully chosen habitat-rich shrubs, nectar-filled flowers, ponds and water features entices butterflies, bees, birds and small mammals into your garden, helping to reduce pests like slugs and aphids while adding interest.

We use recycled, sustainably-sourced and FSC-certified wood in our creations, with peat-free soil and harvested rainwater whenever possible. Companion planting encourages biodiversity, while splitting and redistributing healthy plants avoids unnecessary costs. And our bee hotels, hedgehog houses and 'hog highways' are proving a huge hit, further helping to keep your garden naturally healthy and ecologically sustainable.
